Re: Update regarding FPB Audit (the "Audit") of NRFL A72921 (the "Licence")

As you are aware, Yinka Dene Economic Development Limited Partnership ("YLP"), as represented by its general partner Yinka Dene Economic Development GP Inc., is now overseeing matters respecting the Licence for the corporate licence holder 639881 B.C. Ltd. ("639"). As you are also aware, 639 holds the Licence for the Wet'suwet'en First Nation ("WFN"). We are confident that YLP's new management approach to forest resources will result in better stewardship of the land and increased benefits for WFN's members.

Under YLP's supervision, the following measures have been implemented to respond to the issues raised in the Audit:

1. the remainder of the volume on the Licence has been sold to Canfor with the agreement that Canfor will manage all required activities and obligations;
2. 639, with the assistance of YLP, is in the process of transferring outstanding silviculture obligations on existing blocks to parties that agreed to assume such obligations in accordance with other agreements relating to timber from the Licence; and
3. the allegations against 639 with respect to excessive soil disturbance from certain harvesting operations on the Licence were withdrawn by the Ministry.


In addition, below is a table with the burning activities on blocks from the Licence. These blocks have all been grass seeded as well.

YLP continues to monitor activities related to the Licence, including Canfor's management activities, to ensure that those operating under the authority of the Licence are complying with all applicable laws.

Re: Full Scope Compliance Audit of NRFL A72921

In the commentary of the report *Audit of Forest Planning and Practices – 639881 BC Ltd. Non-Replaceable Forest Licence A72921*, the Board requested an update on the progress made regarding the outstanding abatement obligations and the reporting of the required information for current and past abatement activities to government. As well as a report on the other actions implemented to address the issues identified in the audit (soils, reporting, invasive plants), by February 27, 2015.

The Board received the Licensee's email response, dated March 19, 2015. Board staff have assessed this information, noting that 639881 BC has completed all outstanding abatement, reporting and grass seeding obligations. The Board also received your letter dated May 19, 2015. Board staff have assessed the new information and note that in addition to carrying out the commitments noted above, the remainder of the licence volume has been sold to Canfor with the agreement that Canfor will manage all required activities and obligations. In addition, the licensee is in the process of transferring the outstanding silviculture obligations.

The Board is pleased to see your abatement and reporting obligations are now up to date and the remaining licence volume has been sold to an experienced licensee. The Board now considers this file closed.
