



## Summary of Land Use Plan Status

The information in this document is a supplement to the Forest Practices Board Special Report titled "Provincial Land Use Planning: Which way from here?" That report can be found at: <http://www.fpb.gov.bc.ca> (search for "SR34").

The information summarized in Table 1 and Table 2 below is primarily taken from, "Report on the Status of Strategic Land Use Plans in BC, Oct. 2006 ([http://www.agf.gov.bc.ca/clad/strategic\\_land/lup\\_status.pdf](http://www.agf.gov.bc.ca/clad/strategic_land/lup_status.pdf))." This information was checked against and supplemented with information on the Integrated Land Management Bureau website (<http://ilmbwww.gov.bc.ca/slrp/lrmp/> and <http://ilmbwww.gov.bc.ca/slrp/legalobjectives/approvedlegalorders.html>) and through interviews with government staff in the Integrated Land Management Bureau and the Ministry of Forests and Range.

Table 1 includes plans that we define as "strategic land use plans" (SLUPs). SLUPs are comprehensive regional or sub-regional land use plans, resulting from attempts to achieve consensus. SLUPs include regional land use plans completed by the Commission on Resources and Environment, land and resource management plans (LRMPs) and four other plans (for the Clayoquot Sound, Muskwa-Kechika, Revelstoke and Haida Gwaii areas). Legal orders are indicated as being in place for these plans, where a legal order has been approved that was based on the plan itself. In general these legal orders attempt to facilitate implementation of the entire spirit and intent of the plan.

Table 2 includes plans defined as "sustainable resource management plans" (SRMPs), as well as landscape unit plans and other "lower level" plans. These plans can provide a comprehensive set of objectives that may or may not reflect the entire direction of a relevant SLUP. More commonly these plans are for single resource values (old growth management areas or wildlife management areas, for example), and often only for portions of the SLUP area. Another key difference between these plans and SLUPs is that they are not based on a consensus model. The plans are developed by government staff, and key stakeholders are consulted as appropriate. Some questions about some of this information remain unresolved (indicated by [?] in the affected cell of the table).
